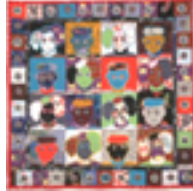


# QUILTED PORTRAITS

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## Supply List:

Sewing machine with satin stitch

Rotary cutter, cutting matt, ruler

Scissors, Pins

Thread—lots of colors

Various fabrics for borders

Buttons, beads, etc for eyes, noses and lips

Pencil

We can save lots of time by having all of our fabric, “Wonder Under”, “Stitch n’ Tear” and black fabric cut into 8 inch squares before the beginning of the workshop:

16- 8 inch squares of different fabrics—contrasting colors and patterns

16- 8 inch squares of “Wonder Under” (please buy regular weight Wonder Under—NOT the heavy duty kind) ;-)

16- 8 inch squares of “Stitch n’ Tear” (this is a Pellon product) OR you may use regular computer paper instead.

16- 8 inch squares of black fabric

PS Please bring several extra 8 inch squares of fabric so that you can trade with others. This increases the possibilities of choices!
