

# QUILTED PORTRAITS

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One day class

We'll be focusing on a sixteen-patch quilt top.

## **Supplies needed:**

Sewing machine with satin stitch

Scissors with a nice sharp point for cutting small shapes

Pins, Needles

Thread—various colors (Thread is part of your color palette)

Pencil and eraser

8 ½ x 11 paper for copying quilt pattern (about 20 sheets)

(We'll be making sixteen photo copies☺)

Please bring a variety of sizes, shapes and colors of buttons

Pressing cloth

## **Please have all of your squares cut before the class:**

Sixteen 8 inch squares of different fabrics—contrasting colors and patterns

Sixteen 8 inch squares of “Wonder Under” (please by the light weight kind—not heavy duty)

Sixteen 8 inch squares of “Stitch n’Tear” (stabilizer—a Pellon product OR you can use computer paper which works just as well)

Sixteen 8 inch squares of black fabric for the appliqué foundation

PS--Please bring five or six extra 8 inch squares for the color choosing process and to share and trade with others. This increases the possibilities of choices!
